Equipment and Rules **NO LOADED FIREARMS** are allowed in the ready room. Revolvers and semi-automatic pistols (32 cal. to 45 cal.) and other equipment allowed. No high speed or magnum ammo. Ammunition shall be supplied by the competitor, and may be factory or hand loaded. Eye and ear protection are mandatory and supplied by the competitor. Open to all shooters 18 years of age and older who are familiar with the standard PPC course of fire. The 60 round PPC match may be fired with either a revolver of 6 inches or less or a semi-automatic of 5 inches or less. The 60 round service match may be fired with either a revolver of 4 inches or less or a semi-automatic pistol of 5 inches or less. The 42 round Service Match is a semi-automatic only match with a length of 5 inches or less. All matches will be fired on cardboard B-27 reduced targets on a 50 foot range. Scoring will be done by the competitors, with the "B" target used to break ties. A \$1 fee will be charged for protests and the Match Director's decision will be final.
